Within a few days of being approached, the Highways Department at the County Council responded to the Association's concerns and the roads are now being prepared for the repairs required (photos attached).

Other projects in the pipeline include organising social events including a May Day event next Springtime, developing volunteer groups to tackle snow clearing etc examining whether a Village Green can be designated on the estates and improving communications to residents.
